Radford University's prospective students should refer to RU's Transfer Guide for complete transfer requirements (see website at bottom of page).

I. Applicants must have both of the following:

1. Hold an active Registered Nurse license with the Virginia Board of Nursing or a Nurse Licensure Compact state or hold an active Registered Nurse license in another state and be eligible for licensure in the Commonwealth of Virginia
2. Have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or above on a 4.0 scale and completed all general education and nursing prerequisites with a grade of "C" or better
