*Students must earn a "Pass" in EDUC 299 before they will be permitted to enroll in any subsequent 300 or 400 level education course.

**NOTE: STUDENT MUST HAVE AT LEAST A 2.5 GPA BOTH IN THEIR LIBERAL STUDIES MAJOR AND OVERALL TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR STUDENT TEACHING PLACEMENT. THEY MUST ALSO BE FORMALLY ADMITTED TO THE TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAM AND MUST HAVE AT LEAST A "C" IN ENGL 150. TO OBTAIN LICENSURE, STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN A 2.75 GPA IN THE PROFESSIONAL SEMESTER AND ACHIEVE A PASSING SCORE ON PRAXIS I AND II.
